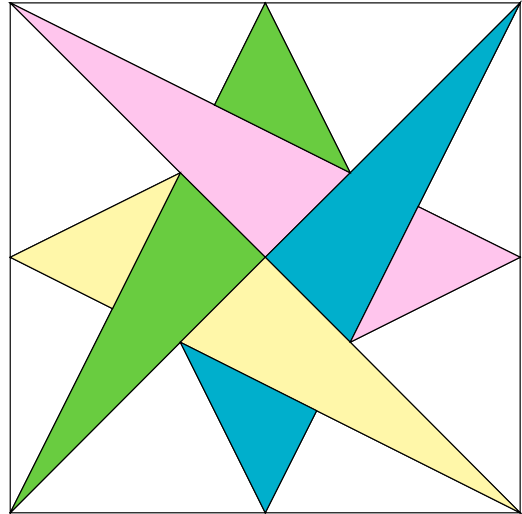


EMPIRE QUILTERS Block of the Month

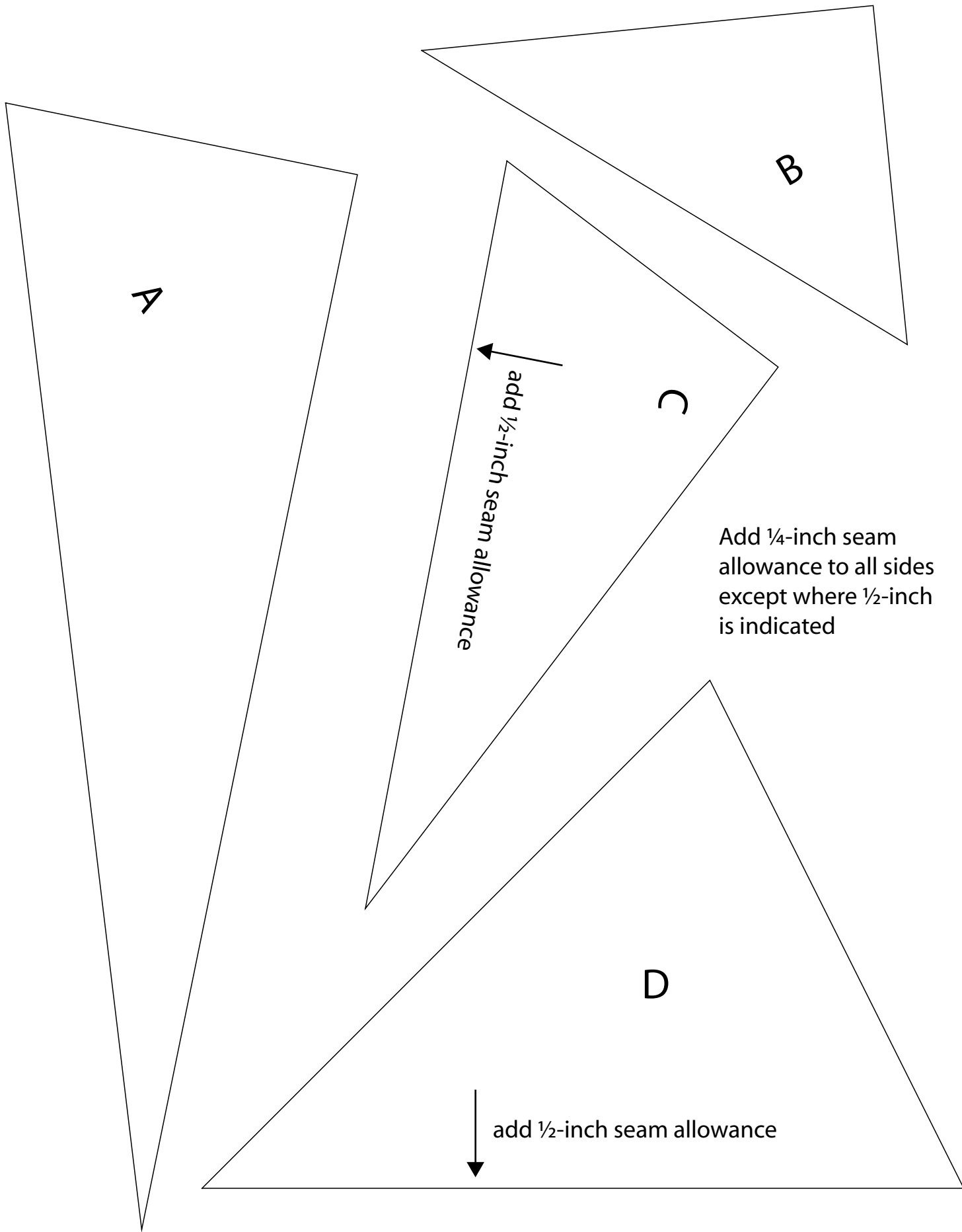
**September 2005**

**STARRY PATH**  
12-inch Finished Block



1. Select four different color fabrics, and one white background fabric.
2. Cut out your templates (see page 2).
3. Cut an “A” triangle from each color fabric, adding a  $\frac{1}{4}$  - inch seam allowance to all sides of the template. You will have 4 “A” triangles of different colors.
4. Cut a “B” triangle from each of the four color fabrics, adding a  $\frac{1}{4}$  -inch seam allowance to all sides of the templates. You will have 4 “B” triangles of different colors.
5. Cut 4 “C” triangles from your white background fabric, adding a  $\frac{1}{4}$  - inch seam allowance to two sides, and a  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch seam allowance to the side marked with an arrow (the outside block edge).
6. Cut 4 “D” triangles from your white background fabric, adding a  $\frac{1}{4}$  - inch seam allowance to two sides, and a  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch seam allowance to the side marked with an arrow (the outside block edge).
7. Following the diagram (on page 3), lay out your block. (This step is important!) You will see that the block contains four A-B-C-D triangles.
8. Sew together each of the four A-B-C-D triangles.
9. Check your layout again using the diagram
10. Assemble the four triangles into your finished block.
11. Admire your work!
12. Bring your block to the **September 10, 2005** guild meeting.
