- 6" embroidery hoop
- 8" square solid fabric ironed onto a piece of freezer paper
- soft pencil, chalk, or disappearing ink pen
- embroidery needle(s)
- embroidery thread — we will have extra, and you can share with others in the class

- assorted embellishments: beads, buttons, ribbon thread, lace ...
