As you make wearable tote bags, you go beyond traditional 3-D. In this technique workshop, you learn 5 exotic and unusual methods that are the trademark of Rami's award-winning works: hexagon and biscuit chopkey, mirror-imaged continuously folded prairie points, harlequin tucks, North American hand smoking and lined prairie points. This workshop could be the answer to those who wish to know how to add 3-dimensional textures and a lot of extra touches to art-to-wear and quilts.

### Supplies needed:

- Theme fabric (colorful print), 1/2 yd
- Background fabric (choose one of the colors in your theme fabric and should be tone-on-tone), 3/4 yd
- 4 more coordinating fabrics (include 2 tone-on-tone fabrics), 1/2 yd each
- Lining fabric, 3/4 yd
- Batting, 3/4 yd
- Muslin, 3/4 yd
- Beads
- General sewing supplies (marker—Clover chalkliner, pins, needle, scissors)
- Sewing machine (bring 1/4" foot if you have one) extension cord
- Iron /iron pad
- Some decorative threads (rayon, metallic)
- 1/2" bias tape maker if you have one
- Rotary cutter, ruler, cutting mat
- 2" X 18" transparent ruler if you have one
