

Empire Quilters Block of the Month April, 2022 MODIFIED FRIENDSHIP STAR


The Friendship Star is a classic 9 patch block. This month it is modified to include a square set on point in the center and a different method for cutting and piecing. You will need only two 10 ½" squares: a strong yellow, orange, or white for the star color and a medium or light blue, preferably tone on tone, for the background. All of the smaller pieces will be made by sewing, cutting, and sewing again.

• Sew the two 10 ½" squares together with a ¼" seam on all sides. Cut the square with an X from corner to corner. Open the 4 cuts revealing four 7" half square triangles (HST). Press the seam toward the blue side.



Place each 7" HST, with the seam running from bottom left to top right, cut overlapping 2 ½" strips from the left side and the bottom of each 7" HST. These cuts will make: Four 4 ½" HST, four 2 ½" HST, four 2 ½" by 4 ½" blue rectangles, and four 2 ½" by 4 ½" star color rectangles. Sew a blue to a star color rectangle along one 4 ½" side four times. Press to the seams to the blue side making four 4 ½" blue and star color striped squares.





Press two of the 2 ½" HST seams to the star color side. Sew the four 2 ½" HST together into a 4 ½" mini block with a star color square on point in the center.



• Sew the nine 4 ½" squares (four HST, four striped squares, one mini block) together into a friendship star block measuring 12 ½".
