The Friendship Star is a classic 9 patch block. This month it is modified to include a square set on point in the center and a different method for cutting and piecing. You will need only two $101 / 2$ squares: a strong yellow, orange, or white for the star color and a medium or light blue, preferably tone on tone, for the background. All of the smaller pieces will be made by sewing, cutting, and sewing again.

- Sew the two $10 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares together with a $1 / 4$ " seam on all sides. Cut the square with an X from corner to corner. Open the 4 cuts revealing four 7 " half square triangles (HST). Press the seam toward the blue side.

- Place each $7^{\prime \prime}$ HST, with the seam running from bottom left to top right, cut overlapping $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips from the left side and the bottom of each 7 " HST. These cuts will make: Four $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ HST, four $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ HST, four $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ by $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ blue rectangles, and four $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ by $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ star color rectangles. Sew a blue to a star color rectangle along one $41 / 2 \prime$ side four times. Press to the seams to the blue side making four $4 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ blue and star color striped squares.

- Press two of the $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ HST seams to the star color side. Sew the four $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ HST together into a $4^{1 / 2 \prime}$ mini block with a star color square on point in the center.

- Sew the nine $41 / 21$ " squares (four HST, four striped squares, one mini block) together into a friendship star block measuring $121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
