Unfinished block size: 12.5" Square
1/4" seams

COLORS:

Background: White, Off White,
Cream

Top Wings: Blue, Purple Solid

Bottom Wings: Coordinating Print

Center: Black



CUT:

Background: Two 3.5" Squares,
Six 2.5" Squares, One 2" x 3.25"
Rectangle and One 2" x 2.25"
Rectangle

Top Wings: Two 5.75" x 7"
Rectangles

Bottom Wings: Two 5.75" x 6"
Rectangles

Body: One 2" x 8.25" Rectangle

Mark all white squares with a diagonal stitching line. Layout your pieces as shown above.

Stitch on the marked line on all squares then clip 1/4 of an inch away from the stitched line towards the corner. Then flip and press. Sew the top and bottom wings together. Sew the 3 center (body) pieces together. Then sew the wings to either side of the body.

Trim to 12 1/2" square.
