1/4" seams

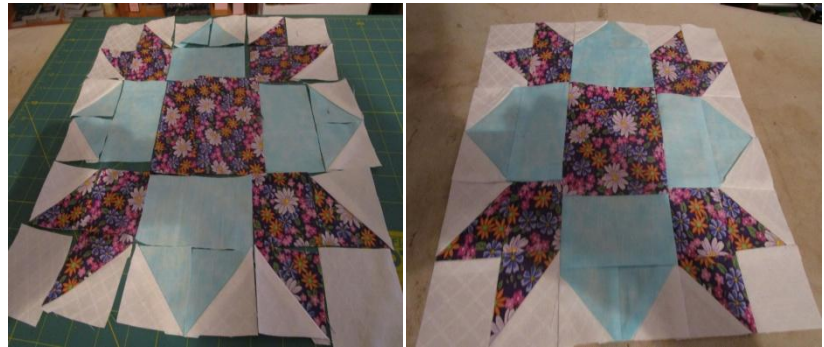
Block of the Month
February 2020
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COLORS:

Background: White, Off White, Cream

Color 1: Solid Blue or Purple

Color 2: Coordinating Print



CUT:

Background: One 2.5 x 10" strip
and two 2-7/8 x 11.5" strips

Color 2: One 2.5 x 18" strip and one
2-7/8 x 11.5" strip

Color 3: One 2.5 x 10" strip and
one 2-7/8 x 11.5" strip and one
4.5" square

Cut the 2.5 x 18" strip (color 2) into four 2.5 x 4.5" rectangles.
Then cut the 2.5 x 10" strip (color 3) into four 2.5" squares.
Then cut the 2.5 x 10" background strip into four 2.5" squares.

Make 8 half square triangles using one 2-7/8 x 11.5" strip of the
background color and one 2-7/8 x 11.5" strip of color 2. Do the
same with the strip of color 3.

The half square triangles should finish at 2.5" inches.

Then lay out as shown in the picture on the left above. You will
first be sewing four pairs of the background/color 3 half squares
together for the blocks center side units. Now make five rows
pressing seams in alternating directions row by row then join
those rows together to make the block shown above (right
picture).
