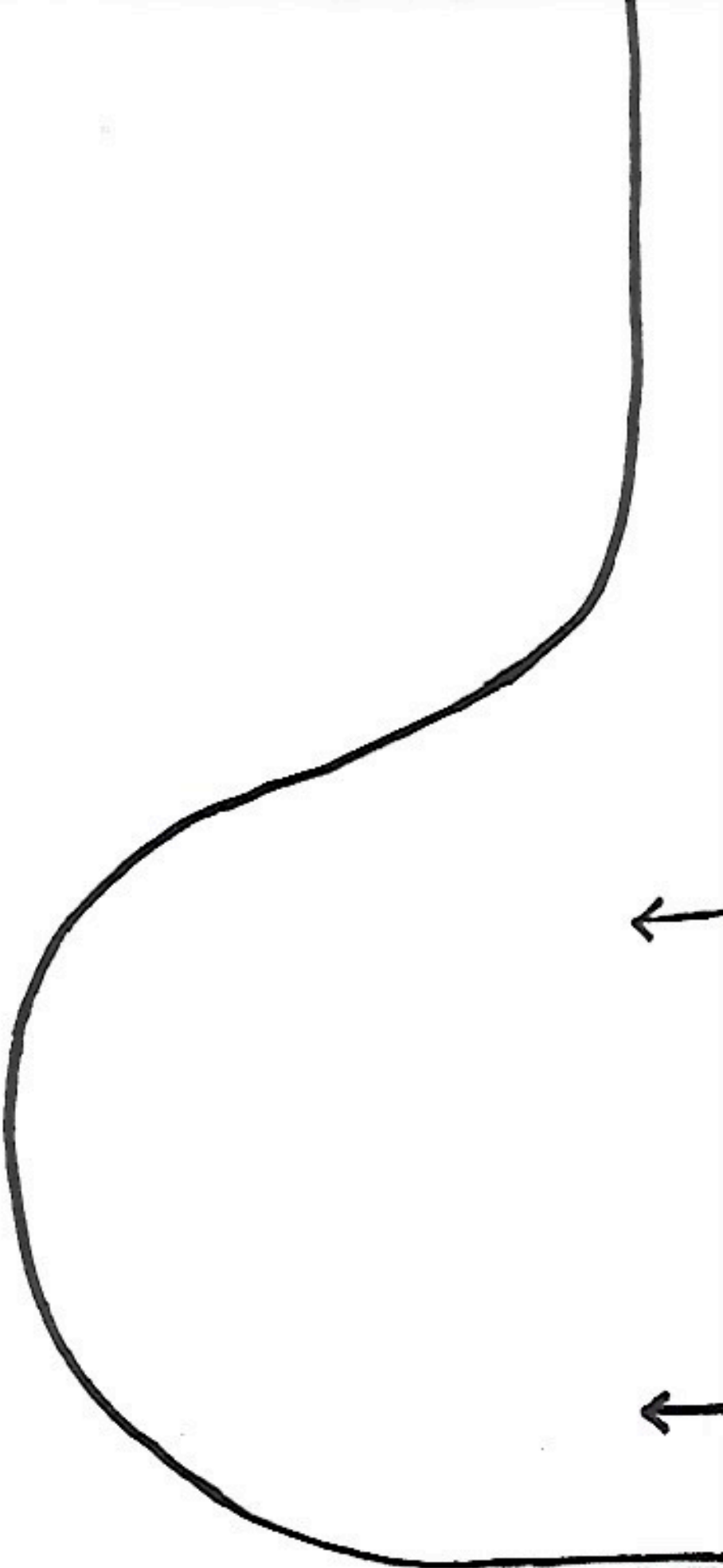


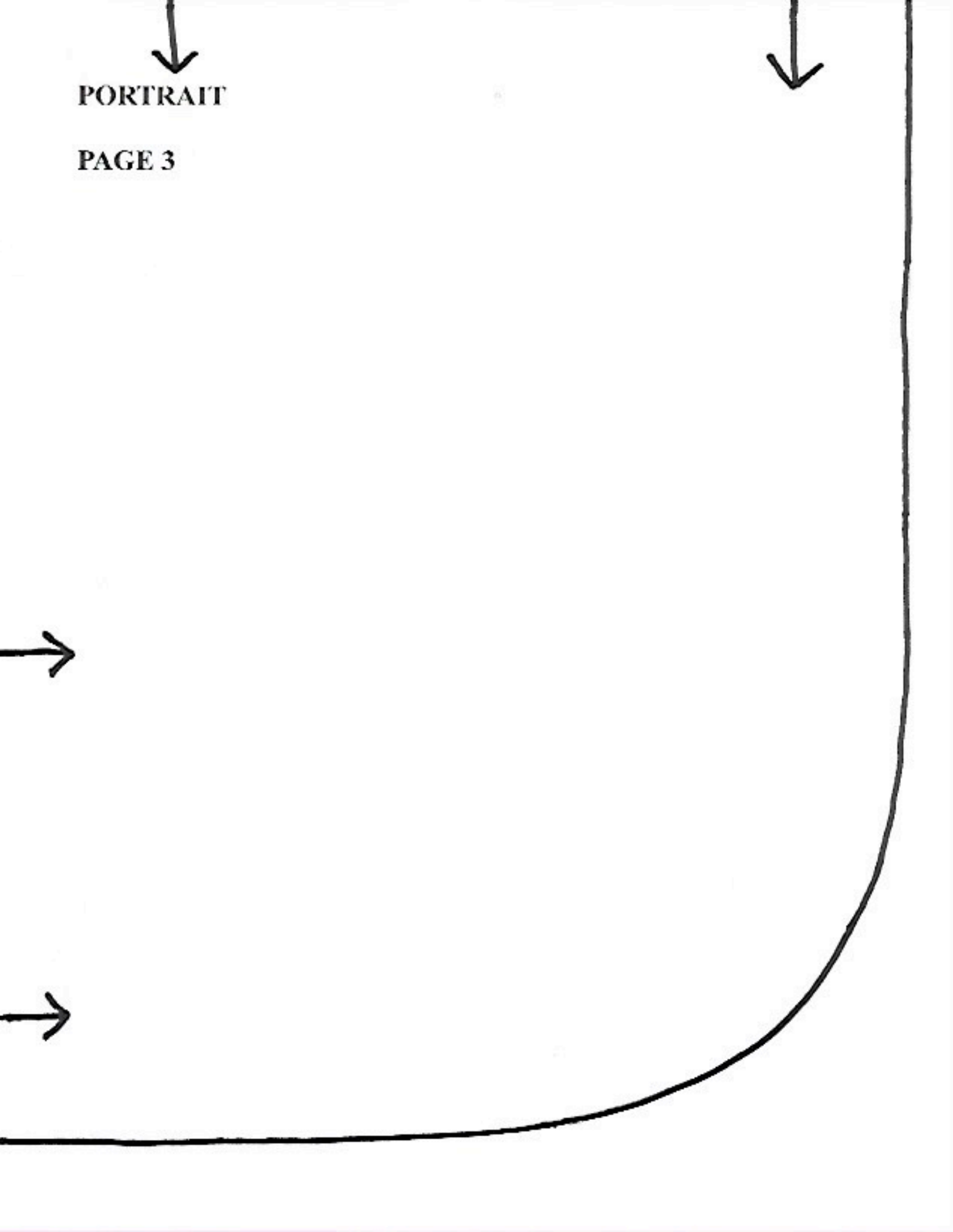

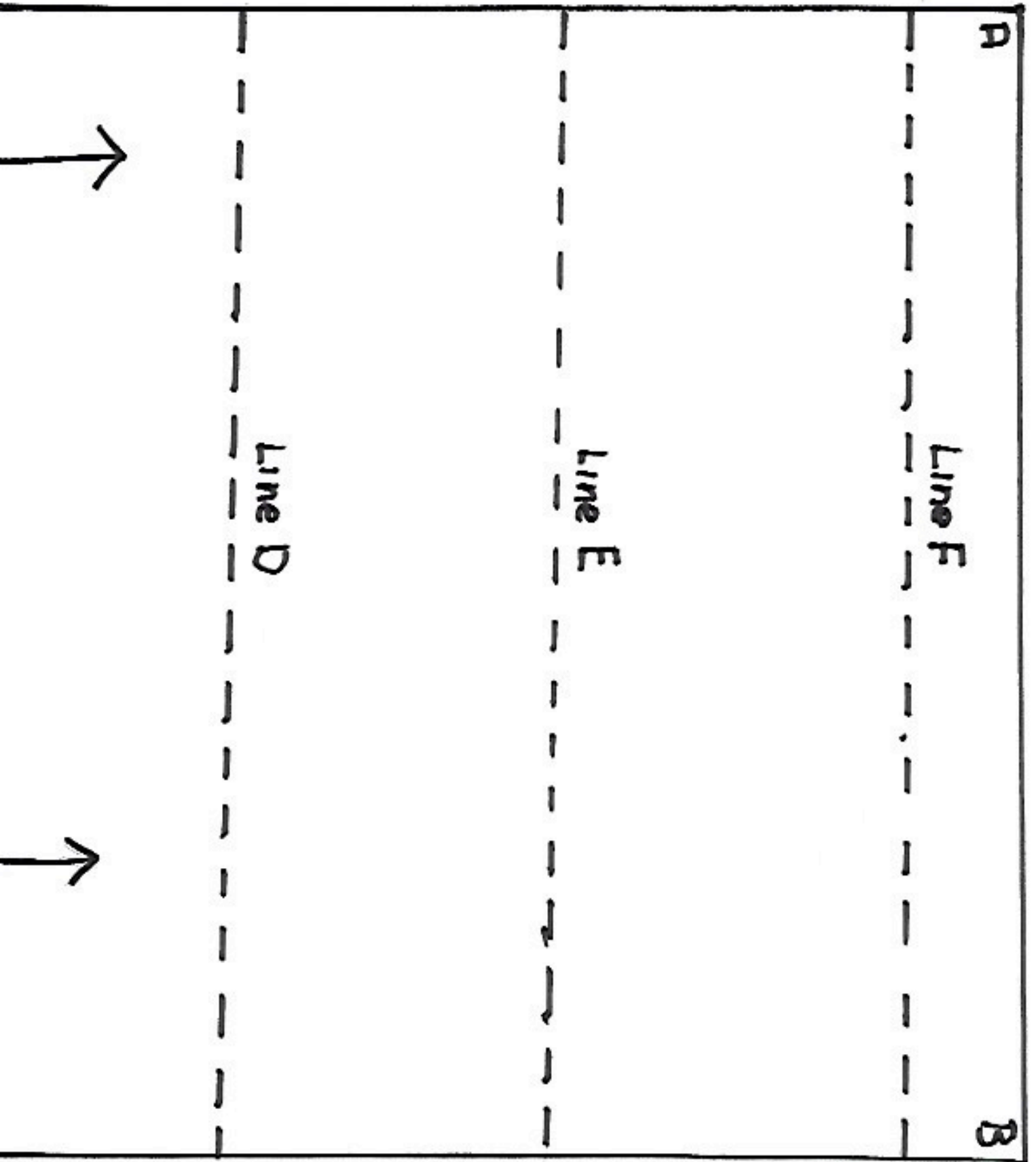

INSTRUCTIONS FOR STOCKINGS

1. Tape together the four pieces of the pattern 1 to 2, 2 to 3 and 3 to 4. Match the arrows. Landscape means the paper should be shorter and wider. Portrait means the paper should be taller and narrower.
2. Lay out pattern on fabric wrong sides together. The line is the cutting line. Cut out two pieces.
3. With right sides together, sew using $\frac{1}{2}$ inch seam allowance from Mark A to Mark B.
4. On each side, stitch down the seam allowances from Mark B to Mark C.
5. Clip all curved areas.
6. Turn right side out and press.
7. Fold down the top to line at Line D so wrong side is showing and press.
8. Fold the same wrong side piece of fabric up to Line E so the the right side is showing and press. This creates the cuff at the top of the stocking.
9. Fold Line F down inside the stocking.
10. Sew around the top of the stocking (making sure to catch the part folded down inside) about $\frac{3}{4}$ inch down from top to make a channel for the drawstring.
11. Using a safety pin attached to a ribbon draw the ribbon through the above channel for a drawstring.
12. Tie each end of the drawstring to prevent it from slipping through the channel.
