



INSTRUCTIONS FOR STOCKINGS

- Tape together the four pieces of the pattern 1 to 2, 2 to 3 and 3 to 4. Match the arrows. Landscape means the paper should be shorter and wider. Portrait means the paper should be taller and narrower.
- Lay out pattern on fabric wrong sides together. The line is the cutting line. Cut out two pieces.
- With right sides together, sew using ½ inch seam allowance from Mark A to Mark B.
- 4. On each side, stitch down the seam allowances from Mark B to Mark C.
- Clip all curved areas.
- Turn right side out and press.
- 7. Fold down the top to line at Line D so wrong side is showing and press.
- Fold the same wrong side piece of fabric up to Line F so the the right side is showing and press. This creates the cuff at the top of the stocking.
- 9. Fold Line F down inside the stocking.
- 10 Sew around the top of the stocking (making sure to catch the part folded down inside) about ¼ inch down from top to make a channel for the drawstring.
- Using a safety pin attached to a ribbon draw the ribbon through the above channel for a drawstring.
- Tie each end of the drawstring to prevent it from slipping through the channel.
