

Kitty Corner Block

Block basics:

- This block is relatively simple. It involves rectangles, squares and triangles
- Finished block size is 9" square. 9 1/2" unfinished
- Use whichever neutral thread color makes the most sense.
- All seams are scant 1/4" seams unless otherwise indicated.



Choose your fabric:

You need three fabrics for this block. Please use a cream colored fabric, a brown fabric and a green fabric.

Cut the following fabric pieces:

Fabric #1 (Cream Colored Fabric)

Cut 8 rectangles 1-1/2" x 3-1/2"

Cut 8 squares 2-3/8"; then cut squares in half diagonally to make triangles

Fabric #2 (Brown Fabric)

Cut 4 squares 2-5/8"

Fabric #3 (Green Fabric)

Cut 4 rectangles 1-1/2" x 3-1/2"

Cut 1 square 3-1/2"

Construct the block:

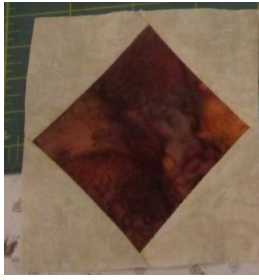


Sew the 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles together with the green fabric in the middle and the cream colored fabric on either side of the green fabric as shown to the left

Sew two cream colored triangles to the brown square as shown on the right.

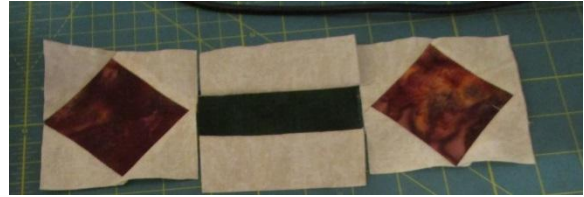
TIP: Fold the squares and triangles lightly to find the center of each and pin. Trim the ears after pressing.



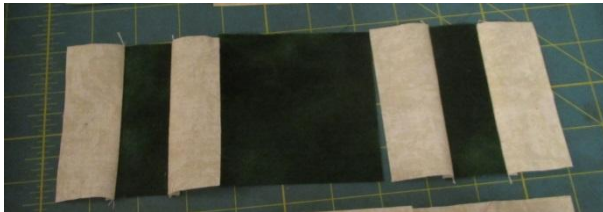


Add remaining two triangles to brown square to create a square within a square block. As shown to the left. TIP: Square up to 3 1/2". There should be 1/4" seam in cream at each point of brown.

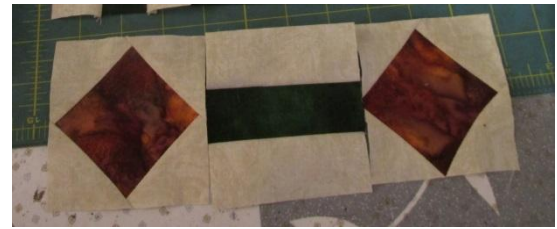
Assemble Top Row as shown to the right



Assemble middle row as shown below



Assemble bottom row as shown to the right



The final layout will look like this:
