Beth Helfter believes in Kickin' Stash

Kickin' Stash, created by Beth Helfter of EvaPaige Quilt Designs, is an inventive, vacuum-up-the-scrap class creates gorgeous modernesque log cabin-style blocks from even tiny scraps, and in the process you can become addicted to the making of this block.

Pre-class homework.

Supply List:

2 yards total assorted scraps in one color family, cut as indicated below.

- I choose the most overflowing color scrap bin and start cutting.
- Cut 36 2 ½" x 6 ½" rectangles; 36 2 ½" x 3" rectangle; 36 1 ½" x 4 ½" rectangles; 36 1 ¾" x 4 ½" rectangles
- 1/2 yd scraps for border. No need to cut before class, or even be the same color family as your scraps

2 yds neutral background fabric to be cut in class. Scraps are the stars of this quilt!

Cutting mat and rotary cutter

6" x 24" ruler

9 ½" or other square ruler

Sewing machine with instruction book. Extension cord

Extra sewing machine needles (whatever you use for piecing)

Neutral thread for piecing

Two bobbins pre-wound with piecing thread

Travel iron and mat

Sewing scissors

Seam ripper

A scrap busting attitude

Chocolate
