

EASY ASSEMBLY SUGGESTIONS - OPTION B Quick Binding

This is a quick way to finish off quilts, and works up very fast for charity quilts.

This should be done with a machine with walking/even feed foot.

The top and batting should be the same size with the backing about 3" larger.

Lay the backing face down with the top and batting centered on it, face up.

Quilt as desired.

Trim the backing to 1" all around.

Turn the backing in ½" to meet the top/batting.

Turn in again $\frac{1}{2}$ " to cover the edge of the top/batting.

Sew down on machine.
