

To make Four Flying Geese - With NO WASTED FABRIC !

Finished size (if you sew all four one on top of the other) : 5 1/2" x 10 1/2"

USING FABRIC IN AUTUMN COLORS one light and one dark.



Cut ONE 11 1/4" square in the lighter fabric Cut FOUR 5 7/8" squares in the darker fabric

Put 2 of the smaller squares on opposite corners of the large square.

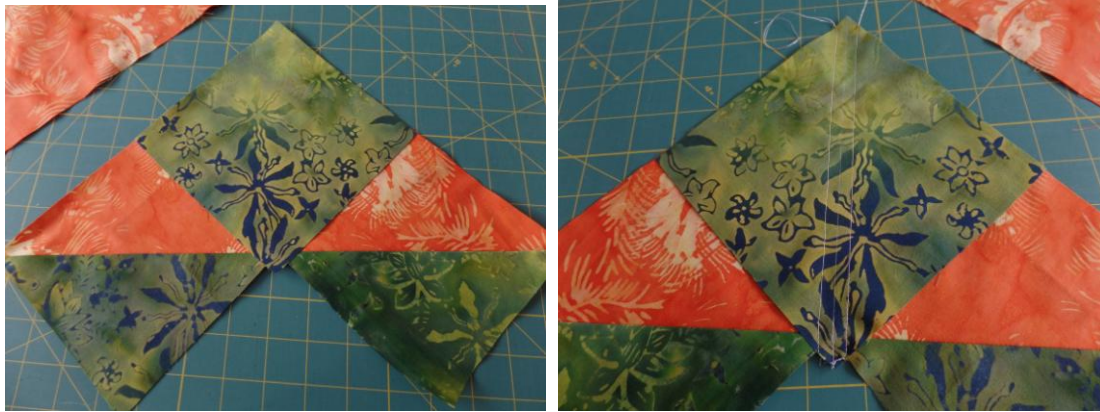


Draw a diagonal line across the center of the square. Notice the 45° line on the ruler. I used a silver gel pen to draw my line.

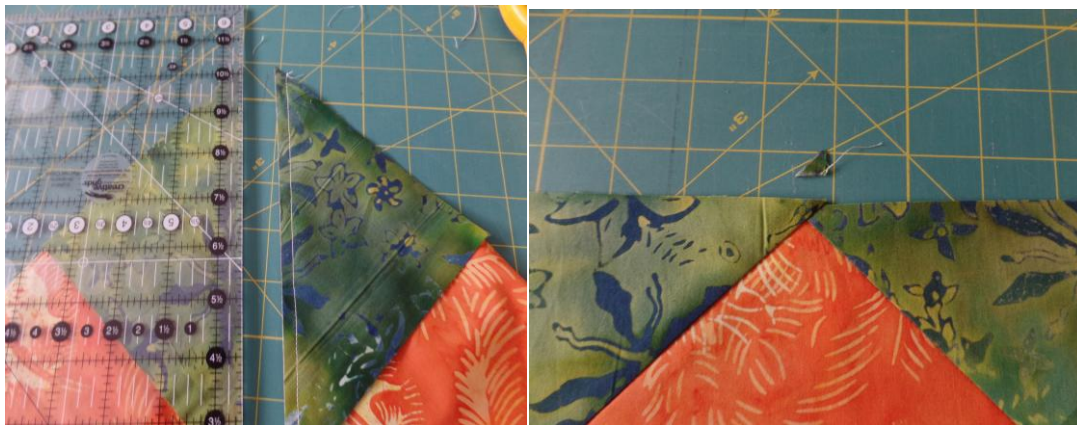
Sew 1/4" on each side of the line you just drew.



Cut on the drawn line. Press the dark triangles away from the light triangle.



Put one of each of the remaining small squares on each of the tops of the triangles. Draw a diagonal line across the center of each and sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the center on each side.



Cut on the drawn line. Press the small squares and trim all the tails off. Sew the 4 flying geese one on top of the other or 2 up 2 to the side and you are done!
