

# Poppy



## Empire Quilters Guild

Block of the Month November 2019

Volume 1, Issue 3

**Unfinished block size: 12.5" Square**  
**1/4" seams**

### COLORS:

**Background:** White, Off White,  
Cream

**Poppy:** Red or Pink

**Center:** Black



### CUT:

**Background:** Four 3.5" Squares

**Poppy Petals:** Four 6.5" Squares

**Center:** Four 3.5" Squares

Draw a line from corner to corner on the back of each of the four background squares with a pencil or chalk. Take each background square and pin or clip to the upper left corner of each of the Poppy Squares right sides together. Sew on the line. Cut the upper left corner adding 1/4" away from the line you just sewed. Press the remaining 1/2 square triangle towards the corner you just removed. Repeat for all 4.

Now take the 4 Center squares and do the same as above on the upper right side of the Poppy Squares.

Arrange with all the black centers together. Sew the top 2 together, if you press the seam of one of the two black centers in the opposite direction you can "nest" the seams. Then sew the bottom 2 and then sew the top to the bottom, nesting the seams as you go.

Trim to 12 1/2" square.
